This document must also include educational information as it pertains to any applicable governmental accountant key responsibilities.

2. Essay: This should be a minimum of 100 words, and no more than 500 words on any one of the following topics:

- Why the applicant is interested in government accounting and/ or finance.
- What the applicant knows about government accounting and/or finance.
- What the applicant would like to learn form government accounting and/or finance.
